  - Non-Attendance: If you do not attend the class, you will still be required to pay the full fee. No refunds or transfers are available for missed classes.
  - Class Cancellation by Us: If we cancel a class, you will receive a full refund or be given the option to reschedule.

## 4. Class Modifications

• Low Enrollment: For 7-week evening classes, if fewer than 3 students are enrolled, we may cancel the class. If this happens, you will be offered a spot in another class or a full refund, including the booking fee.
